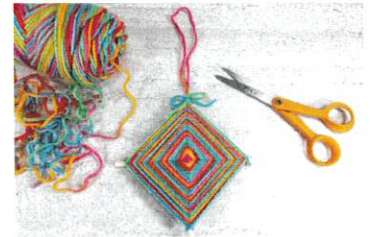
### Craft Group Interest?

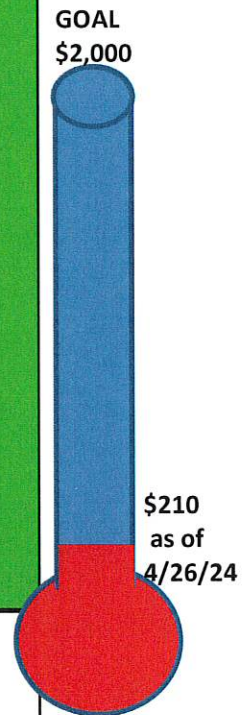

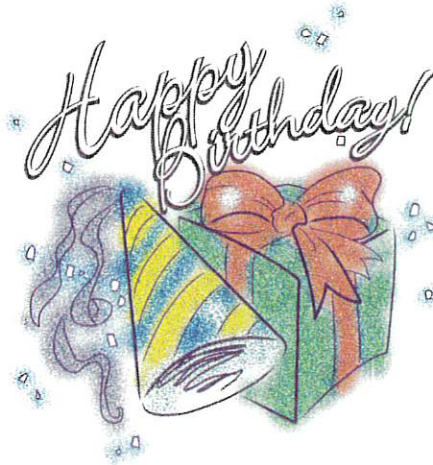
