What is more important in a library than anything else – than everything else – is the fact that it exists. Don't let our Church Library become extinct, visit soon.

NEW KEY FOR EXTERIOR DOORS

After many years of handing out keys (to who knows who) and people having copies of copies made (probably 100's of keys), the locks for all exterior doors are being rekeyed (locks changed to use a new key). This will improve the security of our building and the safety of those who use the building.

A new key will be needed to unlock/lock all exterior door locks; Front/Office outside door, elevator exterior doors, rear door, courtyard and sanctuary door. The locks will be changed on Thursday July 31st.

If your existing key opens doors inside the church it will continue to work – keep it or turn it in to the office if not needed. If you currently have a master key that opens both exterior and interior doors, you will need one of the new keys for exterior locks and your existing key for interior doors. I.e., you will need two keys going forward (old key for interior doors and a new key for exterior doors}.

The new keys are stamped "Do Not Duplicate" and sequentially numbered (1,2,3,4....etc.) for tracking purposes. There is a log sheet in the office to sign for a key. I.e., you'll need to sign the log sheet in order to receive a new key.

If you NEED a key, stop in the office and sign for one. Those who regularly need to enter one of the exterior doors are eligible to receive a key. If you only occasionally need a key for a special event, sign out a "loaner" key, or ask someone with a key to unlock/lock a door for you.

The cost to rekey the locks and for the special new keys is approximately \$710. The church will be reimbursed for the cost by FEMA under the Nonprofit Security Grant Program grant that we received.

**Church Contributions Can

A Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) allows individuals aged 70 ½ or older to make tax-free donations to the church or other qualified charities directly from their IRA which also counts towards their required minimum distributions (RMDs).

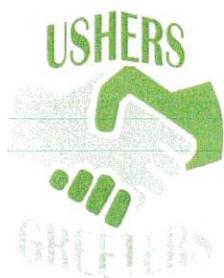

Let the office know that you'd like to be a Greeter/Usher.

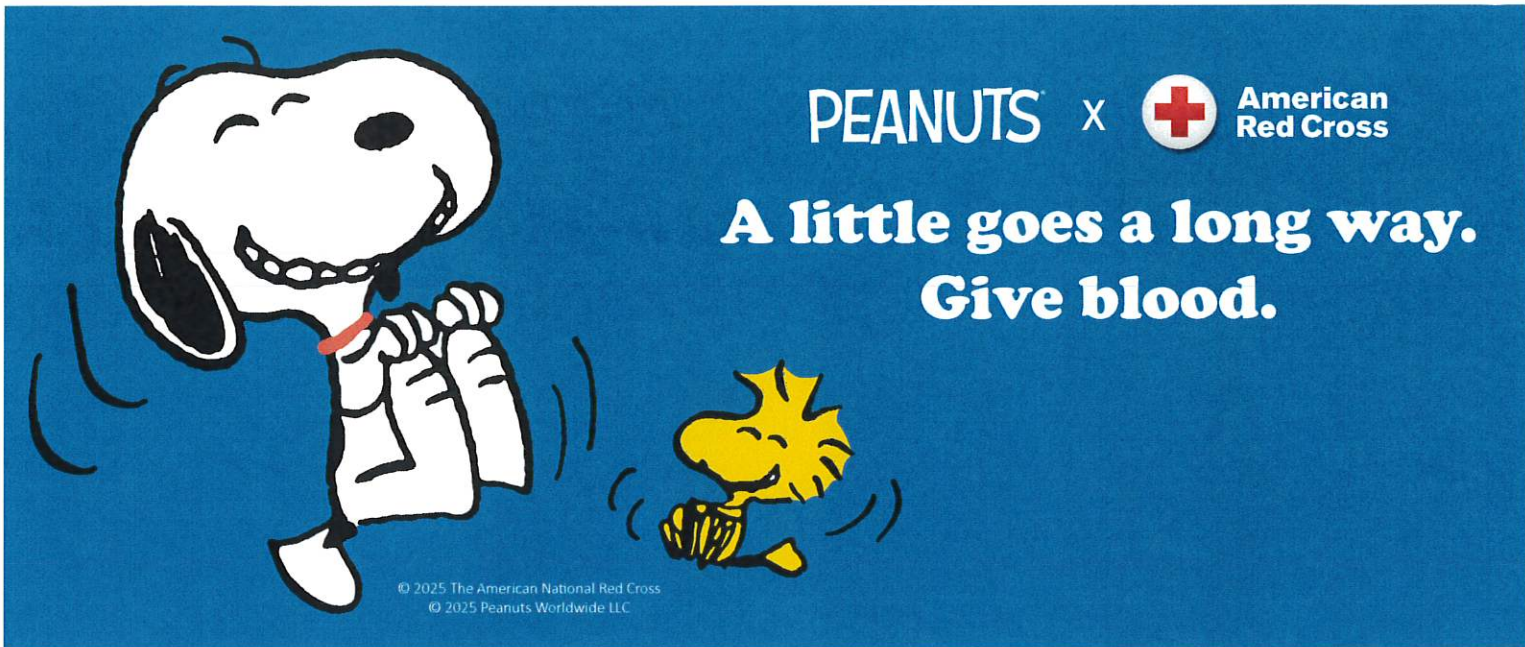
You'll need to do the following things:

- ☐ smile and hand people a bulletin as they enter the Sanctuary,
- ☐ assist visitors by showing them where the nursery, bathrooms, etc. are located,
- ☐ count the people (including choir, pastor, kids, everyone) and record it on the attendance sheet at the back of the Sanctuary,
- ☐ collect offering and put all of it in one offering plate,
- ☐ take that offering plate forward during the Doxology to the liturgist,
- ☐ at the end of worship, collect Fellowship sheets and take to office,
- ☐ if communion, collect and discard cups from pews,
- ☐ call someone to fill in for you if you can't make your assigned date.

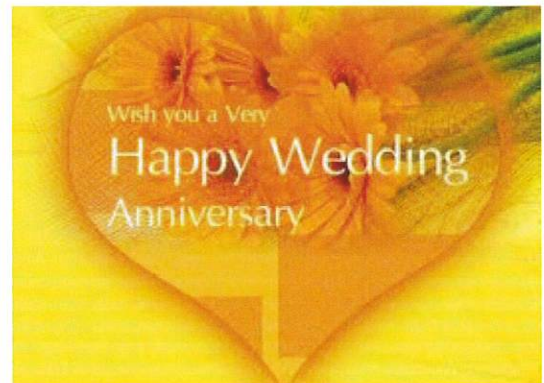
