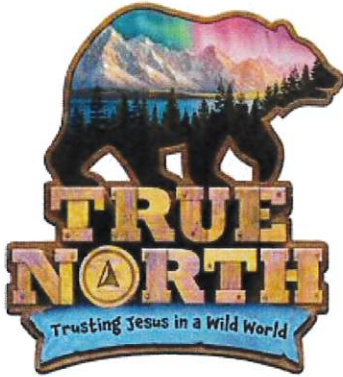
Supporting Joy (Pedrow) and Zack Skarka and both their battles with cancer
