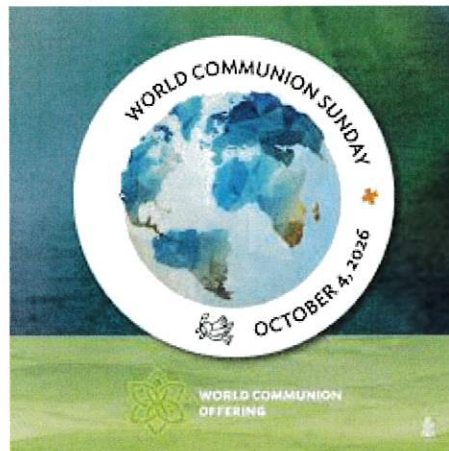


Greeters/Liturgist Schedule

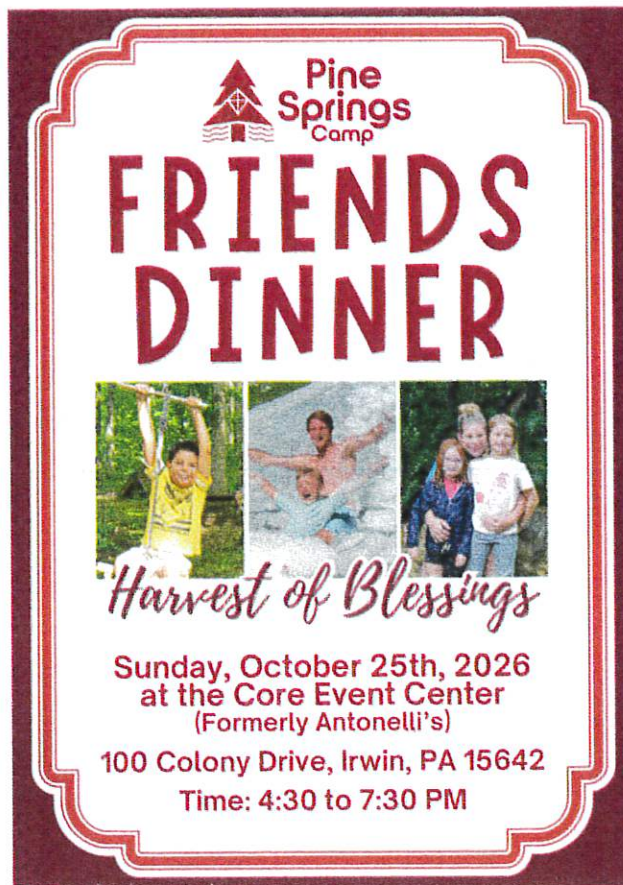

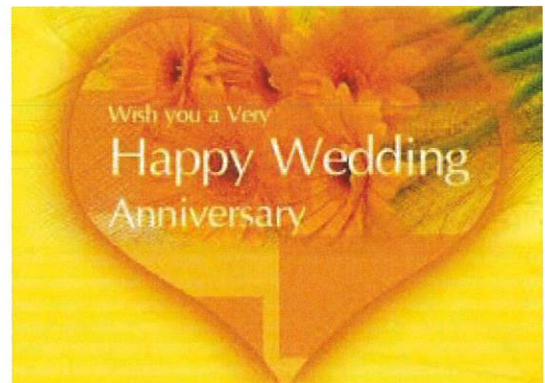

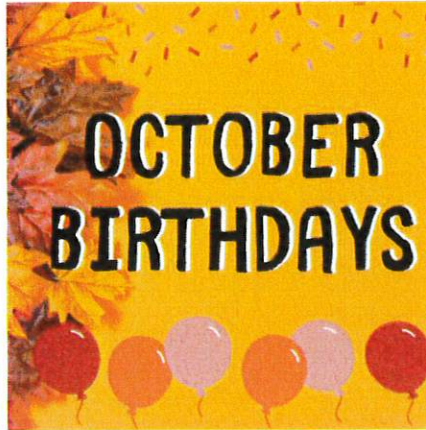
