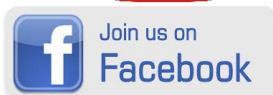

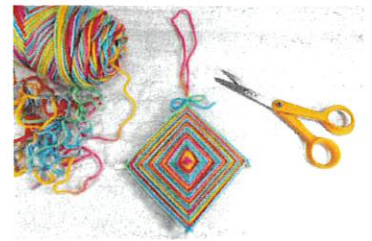
Craft Group Interest?

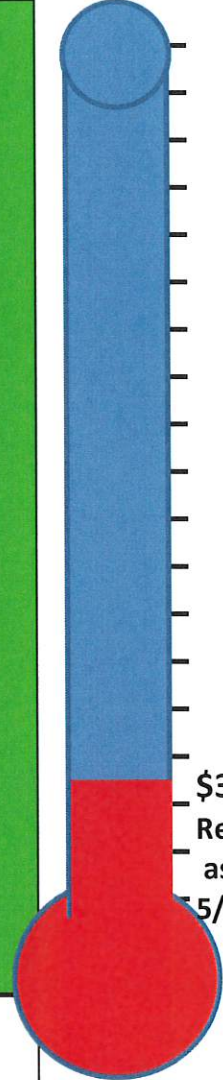

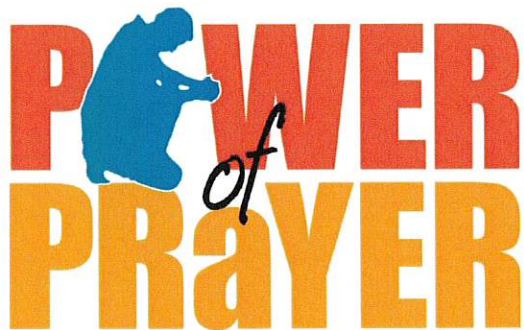

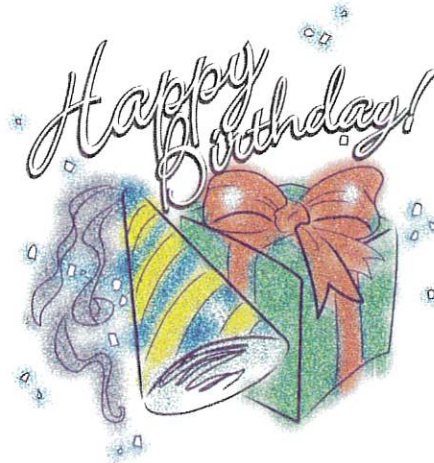
