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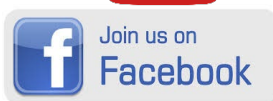

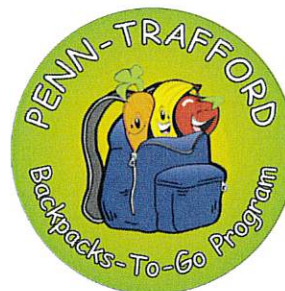


Please bring your empty milk/juice cartons to the Church office to be used for delivering flowers to shut ins. Our supply has gotten low. Thanks for your help.

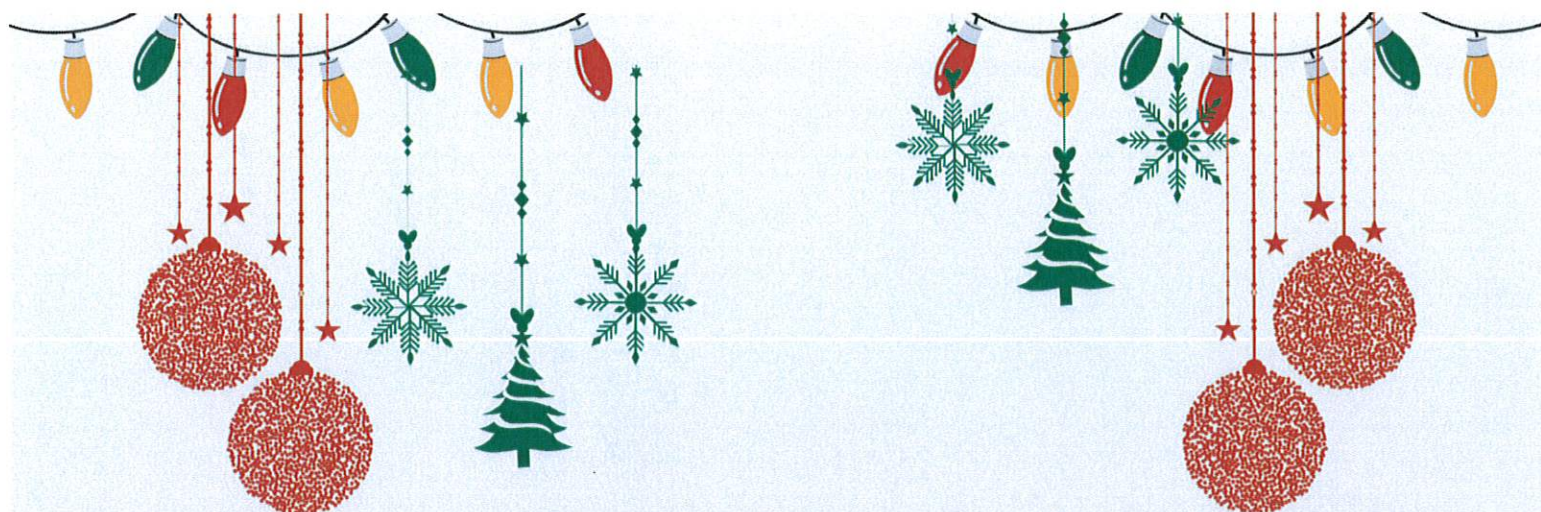

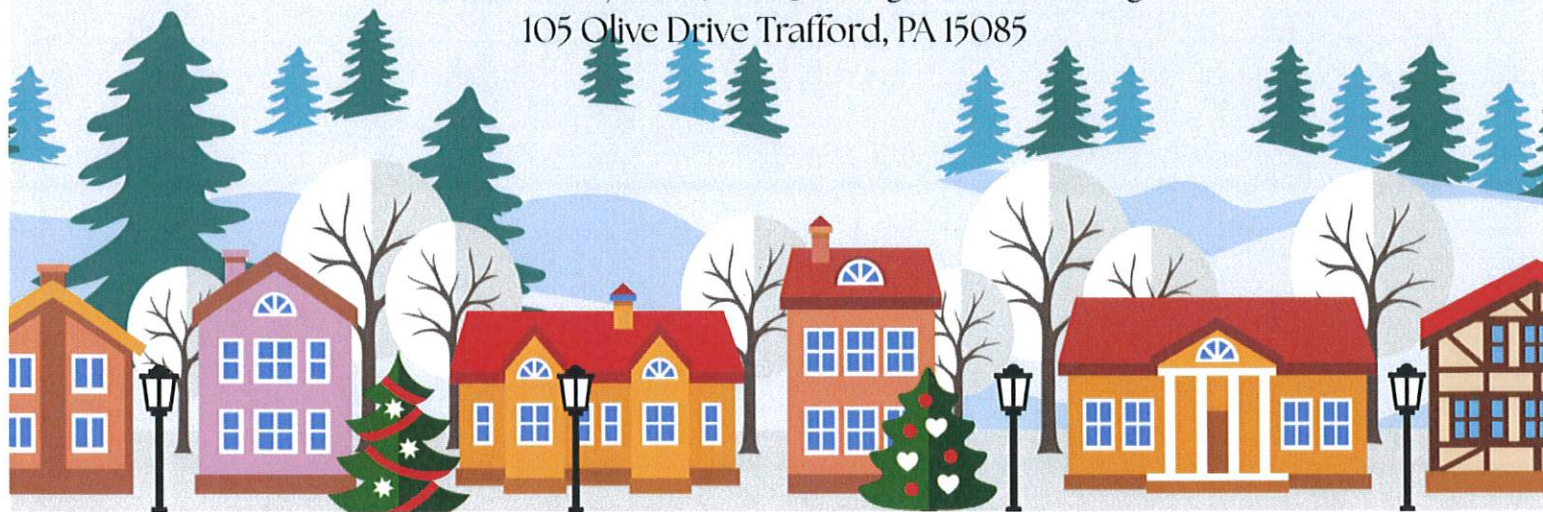

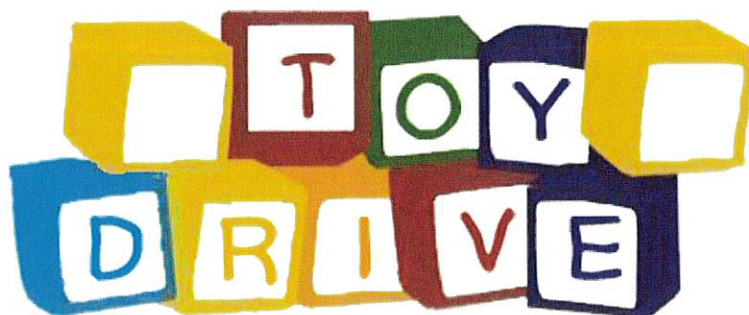

- ☐ smile and hand people a bulletin as they enter the Sanctuary,
- ☐ assist visitors by showing them where the nursery, bathrooms, etc. are located,
- ☐ count the people (including choir, pastor, kids, everyone) and record it on the attendance sheet at the back of the Sanctuary,
- ☐ collect offering and put all of it in one offering plate,
- ☐ take that offering plate forward during the Doxology to the liturgist,
- ☐ at the end of worship, collect Fellowship sheets and take to office,
- ☐ if communion, collect and discard cups from pews,
- ☐ call someone to fill in for you if you can't make your assigned date.

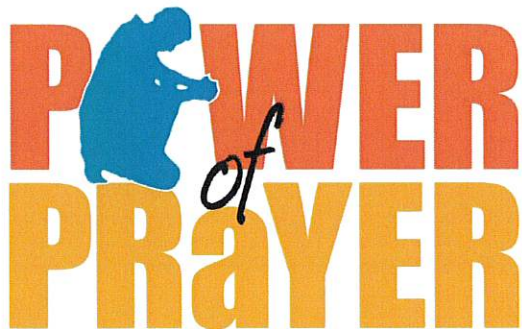
