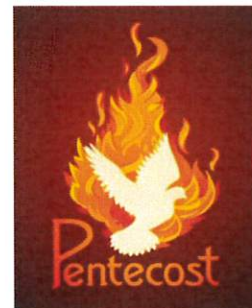
### GRADUATES
